Today – Conditions have become slightly more conducive for showers across Puerto Rico with shower activity noted offshore this morning. While a shower could affect the course at any time today, the highest threat (20%) will be before 11am and after 5pm. Any shower would be relatively brief with low amounts of rainfall. East to east/northeast winds can be expected with gusts of 15-20 mph developing by the late morning. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.05". **Sunrise: 6:41am / Sunset: 6:29pm**

Extended forecast – Trade winds will remain elevated the rest of the week with moisture levels climbing back towards seasonal norms. This should allow intermittent showers to move across the island with periodic chances continuing through the weekend. At this point, showers will likely remain loosely organized and rainfall amounts limited. Winds will fluctuate from E/NE to E/SE through the weekend with gusts of 20-25 mph possible each day.
