**Today** — Air quality alerts have ended as the concentration of smoke will improve as we go through the day. Otherwise, energy rotating around the low-pressure system over Maine will bring an area of showers to Southern Ontario by 7am that will continue through midday/early afternoon before tapering-off. Isolated showers/t-storms will be possible the rest of the afternoon into the early evening. Conditions will dry out this evening with partly cloudy skies.

**Extended forecast** – Drier conditions return Saturday as the low pulls away from the region, partly cloudy skies can be expected with warmer temperatures. Only a slight chance for a shower or thunderstorm with most locations remaining dry. A cold front will approach from the west on Sunday. This will bring the chance for scattered showers, especially during the afternoon into the evening hours. A low-pressure system and associated cold front will provide a better chance for rain and a few thunderstorms on Monday.
