Today – Mostly cloudy skies can be expected this morning before scattered showers develop during the afternoon. Cannot rule out an isolated rumble of thunder, but showers will be the rule today. Scattered showers will taper-off this evening as we lose the heating of the day. Otherwise, smoke from the wildfires will could reduce visibilities and produce poor air quality at times today making for unhealthy conditions for sensitive groups with health issues.

Extended forecast – Forest fires in Quebec will keep hazy/smoky conditions over the region through Friday. Otherwise, a low-pressure system over New England Friday will allow weak pieces of energy to rotate around the low bringing the chances for scattered showers, especially Friday afternoon. Cannot rule out an isolated thunderstorm as well. We should be able to squeeze in a dry day Saturday before a cold front approaches from the west Sunday bringing the chance for showers late in the day. Showers and the chance for thunderstorms will be likely on Monday as the front moves through the region.
