Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

Jordan Spieth earned 500 FedExCup points and his 13th PGA TOUR career win at the 2022 RBC Heritage.

- +13.34** Outperformed the field by 13.34 strokes from tee to green, his third best event performance on TOUR
- 3rd** Third career Final Round come-from-behind TOUR victory (trailed by three strokes entering Final Rd)
- 5** Spieth is one of five players on record (since 1983) who have at least two PGA TOUR titles when making at least three eagles en route to victory
- 4** Played the opening five holes of the Final Round in four under (eagles on 2nd and 5th Hole) marking the fifth time in his TOUR career playing the opening five holes of a Final Round in four under or better
- 16th** became the 16th player to make multiple eagles in the Final Round en route to victory (on TOUR since 1983)
