A few showers and thunderstorms may develop this afternoon along the sea breeze as it moves inland. Light wind this morning will increase out of the south to 10-15 mph by early afternoon and continue into the early evening hours.

Extended forecast – Dry weather returns Saturday as high pressure builds over the area briefly and provides a warm day with highs around 80 degrees. Drier and cooler conditions can be expected Monday as high pressure builds over the region.
