## Luke List (Won/-18)

- Wins second PGA TOUR title in his 253<sup>rd</sup> start at the age of 38 years, 8 months, 24 days
- Played in the third-to-last pairing and made it into a five-man playoff when Ben Griffin, in the final pairing, missed a par putt from 9 feet, 6 inches on the 72<sup>nd</sup> hole; made a 40-foot putt for birdie to win the title
- Since winning his first title at the 2022 Farmers Insurance Open (also in a playoff, defeating Will Zalatoris), had not posted a top-10 between victories, a span of 47 starts; best result this season prior to victory was T11 at The Sentry
- Won the eighth playoff at the Sanderson Farms Championship since 1994 and the third at the Country Club of Jackson (2019, 2022, 2023); marks 11<sup>th</sup> playoff this season
- First five-man playoff since the 2016 RSM Classic, won by Mackenzie Hughes and also featuring Henrik Norlander; last playoff that included more than five players was at the 2021 Wyndham Championship (6; won by Kevin Kisner)
- Finished T2 at the Sanderson Farms Championship in 2016, his best result in seven prior appearances at this event
- Receives 500 FedExCup points and exemptions into The Sentry, THE PLAYERS and the Masters Tournament in 2024, among several other events

## **Additional Player Notes**

- After making 23 cuts in 36 starts on TOUR, it marks the second time in his career that **Ben Griffin** (T2/-18) shoots a final-round 74 (2023 PLAYERS Championship/T35)
- In his debut appearance at the Sanderson Farms Championship, **Ludvig Åberg** (T2/-18), a member of the winning European Ryder Cup team last week in Italy, collects his best PGA TOUR finish in his 13<sup>th</sup> start and the second top-10 of his career (T4/2023 John Deere Classic)
- 2012 Sanderson Farms Championship winner **Scott Stallings** (T2/-18) began the week at No. 130 in the FedExCup standings, but secured a two-year exemption after advancing to the 2022 TOUR Championship for the first time in his 12<sup>th</sup> season on TOUR; moved to No. 98 in the FedExCup standings
- Marks the second time Henrik Norlander (T2/-18) has finished runner-up in a five-man playoff on the PGA TOUR (2016 RSM Classic, won by Mackenzie Hughes); won the Korn Ferry Tour's 2019 Wichita Open in a five-man playoff; has three top-five results in his last four starts at this event (T4/2020, T4/2021, T24/2022, T2/2023); final-round 70 marks his 16<sup>th</sup> consecutive under-par score at Country Club of Jackson
- Despite a bogey-bogey finish, **Mark Hubbard** (T6/-17) posts his sixth top-10 result this season, with his best of the six coming at this event earlier this season (T5/2022)
- With two bogeys in 72 holes, Christian Bezuidenhout (T6/-17) made the fewest bogeys of any player in the field
- While playing in the final pairing, **Carl Yuan** (T6/-17) holed out from 119 yards on No. 17 for an eagle-2 before making a bogey on the 72<sup>nd</sup> hole to miss the playoff by a stroke; notches his first top-10 on TOUR in his 30<sup>th</sup> start
- 2018 Sanderson Farms Championship winner Cameron Champ (T9/-16) has made eight cuts in 25 starts this season, including three top-10s (8<sup>th</sup>/2022 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, T8/Mexico Open at Vidanta, T9/2023 Sanderson Farms Championship)

- With the annual RSM Birdies Fore Love competition running through The RSM Classic, **Zecheng Dou** (12<sup>th</sup>/-15) wins the competition for Sanderson Farms Championship week
- Lefthanded South African Garrick Higgo posts 7-under 65, the low round of the day, to move from T62 to T16
