Today – Mostly cloudy to overcast out ahead of a frontal boundary that may bring few showers towards midday and into the early afternoon. Anticipate that a lull will occur for a period late this afternoon before scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms move in from the west after 6-7pm. Brief heavy downpours are possible with this late day activity. Southerly winds will become breezy for a portion of the late morning to early afternoon before diminishing. The temperature will reach a high in the mid-80s.

Extended forecast – Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms will continue this evening but should decrease in coverage towards midnight. A few lingering showers are possible Friday morning before activity likely comes to an end towards 12pm. Total rainfall through Friday will likely hold below 0.25". Breezy northerly winds are expected to develop by 10am-12pm Friday and will continue throughout Saturday – becoming sustained at 12-16 mph with frequent gusts of 20-22 mph. Dry and cool conditions are forecast Sunday with north-northeasterly winds of 7-12 mph that may occasionally gust to 15 mph after 12pm.
