#### **Additional Notes**

- Last October Dale Hahn became just the second superintendent inducted into the Las Vegas Golf Hall of Fame.
- A winter storm dumped 1.83" of rain 30 days prior to the tournament washing out all 92 bunkers and causing considerable damage to the fifth hole.
- Last year's event was the first with completely resurfaced greens and fairways (old turf types were A1/A4 bentgrass greens and 419 bermuda fairways).
- Average fairway widths in landing areas are 30 yards.
