Friday weather: Mostly sunny. High of 60. Wind ESE 3-7 mph.

Suspension summary: Play was suspended due to darkness on Thursday at 6:15 p.m. PT with 12 players left to complete their round. The first round resumed at 7:43 a.m. PT and was completed at 8:19 a.m.

Beau Hossler (1st/-9)

- Ties his career-low on the PGA TOUR with a 62 (R4/2023 3M Open)
- One of nine players with multiple scores of 62 or better this season (only one with multiple since July 1)
- 16th player to card a score of 62 or better in the first round this season; only one of the previous 15 went on to win (Keegan Bradley/Travelers Championship)
- 1-for-2 to date with the 18-hole lead/co-lead in individual stroke-play events on TOUR (T43/2018 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and T21/2022 Charles Schwab Challenge); also held a share of the lead at the 2023 Zurich Classic of New Orleans (paired with Wyndham Clark) and went on to finish 3rd
- Held a share of the lead entering the final round of the 2017 Shriners Children's Open and went on to finish T7
- Entered the week No. 57 in the FedExCup Fall standings; Nos. 51-60 in the standings at the conclusion of The RSM Classic will qualify for two Signature Events in 2024 via The Next 10 (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, The Genesis Invitational)

Lexi Thompson (T94/+2)

- Making PGA TOUR debut; seventh woman to compete in a PGA TOUR event and first since Brittany Lincicome at the 2018 Barbasol Championship
- Playing on a sponsor exemption, was 1-over through 16 holes when play was suspended on Thursday and went bogeypar on final two holes when play resumed Friday morning

Additional Player Notes

- J.T. Poston (T2/-8) cards a 63, his lowest score on TOUR since he shot the same score in the third round of the 2022 Shriners Children's Open (finished T20)
- Cameron Champ (T2/-8) is coming off a T9 at last week's Sanderson Farms Championship, which was his third top-10 of the season and first since the Mexico Open at Vidanta (T8); Champ leads the field in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green and Proximity (21'9")
- Luke List (T6/-6), winner of last week's Sanderson Farms Championship, is one of three players currently projected to move into The Next 10 (would move from No. 61 to No. 53 in the FedExCup Fall standings); List is looking to become the third player to win in back-to-back weeks on the PGA TOUR schedule this season (would join Lucas Glover, Viktor Hovland)
