Cameron Champ (T1/-12)

- Holds second career 36-hole lead/co-lead in an individual stroke-play event; 1-for-1 to date converting to victory (2018 Sanderson Farms Championship)
- 130 ties his lowest opening 36-hole score on the PGA TOUR (2018 World Wide Technology Championship)
- Has three top-10 in 25 starts this season, including T9 at last week's Sanderson Farms Championship
- PGA TOUR victories (3): 2018 Sanderson Farms Championship, 2019 Fortinet Championship, 2021 3M Open
- Best finish in four prior starts at the event is T28 (2018)

Lanto Griffin (T1/-12)

- First career 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (previous T2: 2020 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, 2021 Farmers Insurance Open)
- With a 64-66 start, 130 marks his lowest opening 36-hole score on the PGA TOUR (previous: 131/2020 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP)
- Seeks second career PGA TOUR win in 123rd start (2019 Texas Children's Houston Open)
- Leads the field through 36 holes in Strokes Gained: Around The Green (5.243) and Strokes Gained Putting (6.005)
- Making fifth start at the Shriners Children's Open (best: T6/2021)
- Limited to 15 starts this season due to injuries to his lower back and rib (best: T15/Valero Texas Open)

FedExCup Fall Notes

- The top 125 in the FedExCup Fall standings thru The RSM Classic will be exempt into all Full-Field events and THE PLAYERS Championship next season
- Nos. 51-60 in the standings at the conclusion of The RSM Classic will qualify for two Signature Events in 2024 via The Next 10 (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, The Genesis Invitational)
- Players currently projected to move into Top 125: Cameron Champ (No. 132 to No. 67) and Lanto Griffin (No. 188 to No. 79)
- Players currently projected to move into The Next 10: Luke List (No. 61 to No. 55) and Sam Ryder (No. 63 to No. 59)

Lexi Thompson (MC/E)

- Making PGA TOUR debut, recorded a second-round 2-under 69, the third round in the 60s by woman on the PGA TOUR
 - o 68/Michelle Wie West/2004 Sony Open in Hawaii
 - o 68/Michelle Wie West/2006 Sony Open in Hawaii
 - o 69/Lexi Thompson/2023 Shriners Children's Open
- Became seventh woman to compete in a PGA TOUR event and first since Brittany Lincicome at the 2018 Barbasol Championship

Additional Player Notes

- Following a runner-up at last week's Sanderson Farms Championship, **Henrik Norlander** (3rd/-12) ties his career-low on the PGA TOUR with a second-round 64 (5 times; most recent: R4/2021 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP); Norlander is seeking to become the first player to lose a playoff one week and win a tournament the next since Patrick Cantlay in 2022 (RBC Heritage/Zurich Classic of New Orleans)
- **C.T. Pan** withdrew prior to the start of the second round due to a lower back injury
- Patrick Rodgers withdrew during the second round
