- Lighter winds than Friday
- Possibly longer spells of rain continuing into Sunday

Outlook for the rest of the Championship

Sunday 23rd – Low confidence on details. Chance of outbreaks of light to moderate rain continuing into Sunday morning. Possible that the rain may be prolonged for a time, and again, heavier bursts can't be ruled out – particularly into the afternoon and evening. (Rain: 2-5 mm, 20% 10-15 mm).
 High: 18°C (64°F). Low: 14°C (57°F). Winds: W to SW 9-12mph gust 13-16mph, becoming W to NW 10-13mph gust 14-17mph by midday. There still remains considerable uncertainty for Sunday for rainfall and winds. Slightly stronger N or NW winds, with gusts up to 20mph during the afternoon and early evening cannot be ruled out.
