



Did you Know??? The average PLAYERS Champion outperforms the field by +3.75 strokes per round en route to victory. This works out to just over 15 total strokes better than the field over the course of the week.

In 2006, Stephen Ames outperformed the field by +5.38 strokes per round en route to victory (best performance vs. the field since 2004). Ames beat the field by over 21 total shots for the week and was six shots better than second place.


Best & Worst Strokes Gained: Total Performances in a Round by a Past Champion

Best Round: +8.99 strokes by Martin Kaymer
Kaymer outperformed the field by +8.99 total strokes en route to his course record-tying 63 in the opening round of the 2014 PLAYERS.

Worst Round: -2.99 strokes by Webb Simpson
Webb Simpson lost -2.99 total strokes to the field en route to a Final Round 73 and victory at the 2018 PLAYERS. Simpson was just the second past champion in the ShotLink era to lose strokes to the field in a round.

2006 PLAYERS champion Stephen Ames outperformed the field by +4.08 strokes per round from tee to green, marking the best SG: Tee-to-Green performance by a PLAYERS champion since 2004

14 PLAYERS champions since 2004 have ranked inside the top 10 in SG: Tee-to-Green.

2021 PLAYERS champion Justin Thomas led the field in SG: Tee-to-Green, outperforming the field by +3.22 strokes per round from tee to green, marking the second consecutive PLAYERS champion to rank No. 1 in this statistic.



Justin Thomas hit 12 of 14 fairways, 17 greens in regulation during the Final Round of the 2021 PLAYERS.


Worst Round: -2.41 strokes by Cameron Smith

Did you Know??? The average PLAYERS Champion outperforms the field by +1.47 strokes per round on approach shots en route to victory.

Seven of the last nine PLAYERS champions have ranked inside of the top 10 in Strokes Gained: Approach-the-Green en route to victory.

2021 champion Justin Thomas outperformed the field by +1.62 strokes per round on approach shots, marking the seventh PLAYERS champion to gain over 1.5 strokes per round in SG: Approach-the-Green.



2004 champion Adam Scott is the only PLAYERS champion who has lost strokes around the greens en route to victory.

2017 champion Si Woo Kim was the first PLAYERS champion to rank inside the top five and gain more than one stroke per round around the greens en route to victory.

2018 champion Webb Simpson outperformed the field by +1.25 strokes per round from around the greens at THE PLAYERS Stadium Course, marking the best SG: Around-the-Green performance of a past champion since 2004.



Prior to Jason Day (2016), the previous 13 PLAYERS champions made an average of 3.8 bogeys on the back nine of THE PLAYERS Stadium Course for the week. Since 2017, the average bogeys on the back nine by the last four PLAYERS champions is 3.6.

No Bogeys on the Back Nine: For the week, Jason Day (2016) played the back nine of THE PLAYERS Stadium Course without recording a single over-par hole, becoming the first PLAYERS champion to accomplish this feat on THE PLAYERS Stadium Course.



2016 PLAYERS

champion, Jason Day was the first to average over 300 yards in Driving Distance (311.6) and Rory McIlroy (2019) joined Day as the only two champions to average over 300 yards in Driving Distance of the last 19 PLAYERS champions.

Club Selection Off the Tee

The last eight PLAYERS champions have had very different club selection from the tee on the par 4s & 5s on THE PLAYERS Stadium Course. 2021 PLAYERS champion Justin Thomas hit driver on 68% of the par 4s and 5s at THE PLAYERS Stadium course, 30% of the time he used a fairway wood and chose an iron off the tee two percent of the time in 2021.



Last season, 100% of the field elected to hit Driver on the eleventh hole, marking the high percentage of drivers used on any hole at THE PLAYERS Stadium Course in 2022. The par-4 tenth hole had 64.8% of the field hit a fairway wood off the tee at the 2022 PLAYERS and the par-4 sixth hole had 22.7% of the field hit an iron off the tee, marking the highest percentage of Fairway Woods and Irons used off the tee respectively.


















