A line of thunderstorms is forecast to reach northeast Florida around sunset this evening with thunderstorms likely tonight. A few of these storms could be strong to marginally severe. Winds will steadily increase today and become gusty by this afternoon. Peak gusts could exceed 25mph late in the day. Temperatures will be warm with a high in the lower 80s.
