Things to Know

- Competing on a sponsor exemption, non-member Cole Hammer holds first career PGA TOUR lead after any round in 15th career TOUR start
- PGA TOUR rookie Ben Griffin (2nd) leads contingent of 16 active PGA TOUR members who reside in the Sea Island area
- Brian Harman, the highest-ranked player in the field, sits T6 after opening 5-under 67 (PL); five of the eight winners on TOUR this season entered the week as one of the five highest-ranked players in the field
- Two-time RSM Classic runner-up Webb Simpson cards 34th round in the 60s in 39th career round in the event
- Justin Suh, who was named 2022 Korn Ferry Tour Player of the Year earlier this week, sits T3 in tournament debut
- Four of the 16 players at 5-under or better played the Seaside Course in round one: Beau Hossler (-6), Callum Tarren (-6), Chris Gotterup (-5), Andrew Putnam (-5)

- Playing on a sponsor exemption, non-member Cole Hammer opens with career-low 64 in tournament debut
- Last sponsor exemption to win on TOUR: Martin Laird (2020 Shriners Children's Open)
- Last non-member to win on a sponsor exemption: Matthew Wolff (2019 3M Open)
- Marks first career lead/co-lead after any round on the PGA TOUR
- Has two made cuts in 14 previous TOUR starts, both coming at the Cadence Bank Houston Open (T27/2022/Memorial Park, T61/2019/Golf Club of Houston/amateur)
- Finished No. 5 in the PGA TOUR University Class of 2022 to earn access to remaining open-field events on the 2022 Korn Ferry Tour and the Final Stage of the 2022 Korn Ferry Tour Qualifying Tournament; finished T59 at Final Stage of Q-School to earn conditional status on the Korn Ferry Tour in 2023
- From Houston, Texas, played collegiately at the University of Texas from 2018-22, winning the team title at the 2022 NCAA Men's Golf Championships and four individual tournaments during his career
- Recipient of 2019 McCormack Medal as the No. 1 player in the World Amateur Golf Ranking

Ben Griffin (2nd/-7) - PL

- PGA TOUR rookie Ben Griffin posts bogey-free 7-under 65 on the Plantation Course in 11th career PGA TOUR start and second at The RSM Classic (MC/2018)
- Held share of the 54-hole lead at the 2022 Butterfield Bermuda Championship en route to career-best T3 finish
- Has two top-fives in last seven PGA TOUR starts (T3/Butterfield Bermuda Championship, 4th/Wyndham Championship)

Miscellaneous Notes

- First-year Member Justin Suh (T3) opens with a 6-under 66 in tournament debut
- **Brian Harman** (T6), one of 16 active PGA TOUR members that live in the Sea Island area, is the highest-ranked player in the field at No. 24 in the Official World Golf Ranking; has two top-10s in 10 starts in The RSM Classic (T4/2017, T10/2013); has 25 top-10s on the PGA TOUR since the start of the 2017-18 season, the most of any player without a win in that span (second: Adam Hadwin, 22)
- Two-time RSM Classic runner-up **Webb Simpson** (T6) makes a hole-in-one at No. 3 on the Plantation Course (4-hybrid; scorecard yardage: 219 yards), his fourth career ace on TOUR and first since the 2020 WM Phoenix Open, which he went on to win (the last player to accomplish the feat); has five top-10s in 10 starts at the event, including two playoff losses (2011, 2019); his 5-under 67 on the Plantation Course marks his 34th round in the 60s in 39 rounds in the event
- Davis Love III (wrist) and Anders Albertson (back) withdrew before the start of the round; David Lipsky, Trey Mullinax (ankle), Danny Willett (shoulder) withdrew after the round
