**Today** – Intermittent waves of moderate to heavy rain are forecast to move in off the ocean this morning through the early afternoon before activity becomes more scattered in nature for the late afternoon and evening hours. There is slim threat for a stray rumble of thunder, but instability is likely to remain limited. Northeasterly winds will become breezy, sustained between 10-16 mph with gusts of 18-22 mph.

**Extended forecast** – Scattered showers will increase in coverage after midnight, with periods of moderate to briefly heavy rain forecast through daybreak Friday before activity becomes more scattered and diminishes in coverage for late Friday morning through Friday afternoon. A stray rumble of thunder is possible Friday morning, with a lightning probability of 10%. Additional rainfall of 0.30 – 0.60" is forecast for Thursday evening through Friday morning. An isolated shower may occur Saturday morning out ahead of a weak cold front before dry conditions return for Saturday afternoon and continue through Sunday.
