**Today** – Sunny becoming partly cloudy this afternoon as temperatures rise into the upper 90s. There is a 10-20% chance for a pop-up shower or brief thunderstorm after 2-3pm this afternoon. The heat index is forecast to reach a peak value near 105°F. Winds will be north-northwesterly at 5-12 mph.

**Tomorrow** – Weakening of a high pressure ridge and an increase in moisture will allow for a scattered coverage of thunderstorms to develop across the Atlanta metro area Sunday afternoon. The highest rain and thunderstorm probabilities are expected between 5-8pm. Brief heavy downpours and thunderstorm wind gusts to 35 mph will be possible within afternoon and evening activity. The temperature will reach a high in the mid-90s. Winds will largely remain light and variable throughout the day outside of any storms.

**Heat index ≥ 100°F 12-6pm. Forecast peak heat index value: 105°F.**

**Forecast rainfall through 8pm: 0.10" – 0.25". Sunrise: 7:07am / Sunset: 8:09pm**
