Today – Sunny becoming partly cloudy this afternoon as temperatures climb into the mid-90s. There will be an isolated (10-20%) probability for a pop-up shower or thunderstorm after 4-5pm. A potential line of thunderstorms drifting in from the northeast may impact the Atlanta metro between 7-9pm. Brief heavy downpours and thunderstorm wind gusts to 35 mph will become possible should this evening band of thunderstorms materialize. The heat index may briefly eclipse 100°F late this afternoon.

Extended forecast – Sunny to mostly sunny skies and dry conditions are anticipated Friday. An isolated coverage of pop-up thunderstorms are forecast to develop after 2pm Saturday. Weakening of a high pressure ridge and an increase in moisture will allow for a few thunderstorms to develop across the Atlanta metro area Sunday afternoon as the temperature tops out in the mid-90s. The heat index is likely to climb into the 103°F to 104°F range on Friday and Saturday and should reach a max of 100°F or 101°F on Sunday.
