TOP STORYLINES

Wyndham Clark won last week's U.S. Open by one stroke over Rory McIlroy, earning his second PGA TOUR victory and first major title. Clark, whose first career win came last month at the Wells Fargo Championship, moved to career-high positions in the FedExCup standings (No. 4) and Official World Golf Ranking (No. 13). The last player to win a major and win on TOUR the following week was Tiger Woods in 2006 (PGA Championship, WGC-Bridgestone Invitational).

Jon Rahm enters the week as the FedExCup leader with four wins this season, including the Masters Tournament. With a win this week, Rahm would become the first player to win five times in a season since Justin Thomas in 2016-17. With 3,117 FedExCup points so far this season, Rahm has the fourth-highest total in a single FedExCup Regular Season since the inception of the FedExCup in 2007.

With two wins on the season (WM Phoenix Open, THE PLAYERS Championship), World No. 1 **Scottie Scheffler** leads the PGA TOUR with 13 top-10s this season and has finished T12 or better in each of his last 16 starts. Scheffler has made three prior starts at the Travelers Championship, with his best result coming in 2022 (T13).

2022 champion **Xander Schauffele** is defending the second of his three titles from the 2021-22 season. Schauffele finished T4 at the Zurich Classic of New Orleans with partner Patrick Cantlay in his first attempt and is also the defending champion at next month's Genesis Scottish Open. Schauffele, who is tied with Jon Rahm for second-most top-10s on TOUR this season (9), has never successfully defended a title on TOUR.

Reigning FedExCup Champion and World No. 3 **Rory McIlroy** is coming off a solo-second at last week's U.S. Open, his 10th career runner-up on TOUR and second of the season (T2/Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard). McIlroy is making his fifth start at the Travelers Championship and has finished in the top 20 in all four prior starts with no top-10s (T17/2017, T12/2018, T11/2020, T19/2022). The Travelers Championship is the only PGA TOUR event at which McIlroy has made more than two starts and failed to record a top-10.

ADDITIONAL STORYLINES

McIlroy has finished in the top-10 in each of his last four starts, his longest such streak since he had seven straight in his last seven starts before the 2019-20 season was suspended due to COVID-19. During that span, McIlroy won the FedExCup and reached the No. 1 position in the Official World Golf Ranking.

2021 Travelers Championship winner **Harris English** finished T8 at last week's U.S. Open, recording his fourth top-10 of the season. English's victory over Kramer Hickok in 2021 tied the second-longest sudden-death playoff in PGA TOUR history (eight holes).

Sahith Theegala finished T2 at the 2022 Travelers Championship, one of two career runner-up finishes in his career (T2/2022 RSM Classic). Theegala is one of three players in the top 25 of the Official World Golf Ranking that has not won on the PGA TOUR, along with Cameron Young (No. 17) and Tommy Fleetwood (No. 20).

PGA TOUR rookie **Austin Eckroat** has three top-10s in his last nine starts, including a T10 at last week's U.S. Open. Eckroat made his first professional start on the PGA TOUR at the 2021 Travelers Championship (T47).

Michael Thorbjornsen, who just completed his junior year at Stanford University, received a second consecutive sponsor exemption to the Travelers Championship after finishing fourth in 2022.
