Things to Know

- Three players share 36-hole lead, tied for most in event history (2021, 2007) and most on TOUR since 2022 RSM Classic
- Hatton, Lashley each seek second PGA TOUR win; Clark in search of maiden TOUR title
- Xander Schauffele posts consecutive rounds in the 60s for the first time at the Wells Fargo Championship
- Justin Thomas posts best 36-hole score in fifth Wells Fargo Championship appearance
- Rory McIlroy makes cut on number to avoid three consecutive missed cuts in stroke play events on TOUR

Tyrrell Hatton (T1/-8)

- Second career 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (other: 2020 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard/Won)
- 65 marks low score in 10 rounds in the Wells Fargo Championship (previous: 66/2022/R2 at TPC Potomac); ties low round of season (R4/THE PLAYERS Championship)
- Played his final four holes (Nos. 6-9) in 4-under (birdie-eagle-par-birdie)
- Finished runner-up at the 2023 PLAYERS Championship, his best finish of the season
- Making third start at the Wells Fargo Championship (T42/2018, T37/2022)
- Missed cut at 2017 PGA Championship at Quail Hollow
- Seeks second career PGA TOUR win (2020 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard)
- Six-time winner on the DP World Tour (most recent: 2021 Abu Dhabi HSBC Championship)

Nate Lashley (T1/-8)

- Third 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (most recent: 2019 Rocket Mortgage Classic/Won)
- One of four bogey-free rounds in the second round (others: Stewart Cink, Harris English, Alex Smalley)
- Records consecutive rounds in the 60s for the first time in five starts in the event
- One made cut in four previous starts at the Wells Fargo Championship (MC/2018, T45/2019, MC/2021, WD/2022)
- Won lone PGA TOUR title at the 2019 Rocket Mortgage Classic after getting in as an alternate
- Finished T3 at the Puerto Rico Open, his best finish in 17 previous starts this season

Wyndham Clark (T1/-8)

- Third 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (most recent: 2022 RBC Canadian Open/T7)
- Records 33rd round in the 60s on the season, the third-most among players on TOUR (most: 34/two players/Andrew Putnam, Patrick Rodgers)
- Seeks first PGA TOUR win; lost in a playoff at the 2020 Bermuda Championship for lone TOUR runner-up
- Has a career-best five top-10s on the season, highlighted by three top-six finishes in his last five starts (3rd/Zurich Classic of New Orleans with partner Beau Hossler, 5th/Valspar Championship, 6th/Corales Puntacana Championship)
- Making third start in the Wells Fargo Championship (MC/2019, T43/2021)

Miscellaneous notes

- Xander Schauffele (T4) posts consecutive rounds in the 60s for the first time in four starts in the Wells Fargo Championship
- Making his fifth start in the Wells Fargo Championship, 2017 PGA Championship (at Quail Hollow) winner **Justin Thomas** (T4) opens 68-67—135 for his best 36-hole score in the event (previous: 142/three occasions)
- Adam Scott (T4) seeks first top-10 in ninth start of the season (best finish this season: T21/Sony Open in Hawaii)
- First-round leader Tommy Fleetwood (T10) sits two shots back after an even-par 71 in round two
- Defending champion Max Homa (T13) sits three shots off the lead; no player has every successfully defended
- Three-time Wells Fargo Championship winner **Rory McIlroy** (T55) opens with rounds of 68-73 to make the cut on the number; has one missed cut in 12 starts (2011)
- Mark Hubbard (T55) makes a hole-in one at No. 17 using a 6-iron from 198 yards marking his third career ace on TOUR
- North Carolina resident Akshay Bhatia (T55) is the only player with two eagles through 36 holes
