**Things to Know**

- In search of his first career PGA TOUR victory, Wyndham Clark leads by two strokes over World No. 5 Xander Schauffele
- Clark cards season-low 63 for low round of the tournament
- Schauffele seeks eighth career PGA TOUR title and first of season
- Adam Scott seeks first top-10 finish since the 2022 BMW Championship (T5)
- Tyrrell Hatton, Tommy Fleetwood each look to become record fourth English winner on TOUR this season

- 7 Third-round leaders/co-leaders to win the Wells Fargo Championship (most recent: Max Homa/2019)
- 15 Third-round leaders/co-leaders to win on TOUR in 2022-23 (most recent: Tony Finau/Mexico Open at Vidanta)

**Wyndham Clark (1<sup>st</sup>/-16)**

- Second 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (other: 2019 Honda Classic); led by one and carded a 2-over 72 to finish T7
- Posts eight birdies (two shy of personal record) against no bogeys for low round of the tournament and low round of the season (previous: 64/R3/The American Express)
- 197 marks second-lowest 54-hole total on TOUR (low: 195/2020 Shriners Children’s Open)
- Held share of the 36-hole lead with Tyrrell Hatton (T3) and Nate Lashley (T9)
- Records 34<sup>th</sup> round in the 60s on the season, tied for most among players on TOUR (others: Andrew Putnam, Patrick Rodgers)
- In search of first PGA TOUR win; players to make the Wells Fargo Championship their maiden TOUR title: Anthony Kim (2008), Rory McIlroy (2010), Rickie Fowler (2012), Derek Ernst (2013) and Max Homa (2019)
- Seven first-time winners on TOUR in 2022-23 (most recent: Nick Hardy and Davis Riley at the Zurich Classic of New Orleans)
- Best finish on TOUR: 2020 Bermuda Championship/runner-up (lost in a playoff to Brian Gay)
- Has a career-best five top-10s on the season, highlighted by three top-six finishes in his last five starts (3<sup>rd</sup>/Zurich Classic of New Orleans with partner Beau Hossler, 5<sup>th</sup>/Valspar Championship, 6<sup>th</sup>/Corales Puntacana Championship)
- Making third start in the Wells Fargo Championship (MC/2019, T43/2021)

### **Xander Schauffele (2<sup>nd</sup>/-14)**

- 199 marks lowest 54-hole tournament total since the 2022 Travelers Championship (193/Won)
- Seven-time PGA TOUR winner is in search of first win of the season; won three times in 2021-22 season (2022 Zurich Classic of New Orleans with partner Patrick Cantlay, Travelers Championship, Genesis Scottish Open)
- Five of his seven wins were in come-from-behind fashion; held the outright 54-hole lead in his last two wins (2022 Travelers Championship, 2022 Genesis Scottish Open)
- Seven top-10s on the season, including his last four starts (WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play/T5, Masters Tournament/T10, RBC Heritage/4, Zurich Classic of New Orleans/T4); only Jon Rahm and Scottie Scheffler have more (8)
- Making fourth start in the Wells Fargo Championship (T24/2017, T72/2018, T14/2021); in 12 rounds prior to the start of the week, had two rounds in the 60s; missed the cut at the 2017 PGA Championship held at Quail Hollow
- Represented the winning U.S. Team at the 2022 Presidents Cup at Quail Hollow

### **Miscellaneous notes**

- **Adam Scott** (T3) seeks first top-10 in ninth start of the season (best finish this season: T21/Sony Open in Hawaii); making his 11<sup>th</sup> start in the event where he has two top-10s (3<sup>rd</sup>/2006, T8/2008); Represented the International Team at the 2022 Presidents Cup at Quail Hollow, his record 10<sup>th</sup> appearance in the team competition
- **Tyrrell Hatton** (T3) and **Tommy Fleetwood** (T5) each seek to become the fourth player from England to win on TOUR this season, which would set the record for most English winners in a single TOUR season: Justin Rose/AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, Matt Wallace/Corales Puntacana Championship, Matt Fitzpatrick/RBC Heritage
- **Most winners from England in a single season on record (1983-present)**
  - 3, 2022-23 (Justin Rose, Matt Wallace, Matt Fitzpatrick)
  - 3, 2017-18 (Justin Rose, Paul Casey, Ian Poulter)
  - 3, 2010 (Ian Poulter, Justin Rose, Lee Westwood)
- **Brendon Todd** (8<sup>th</sup>) played Nos. 7-10 in 5-under (eagle-birdie-birdie-birdie) to tie his career-low, four-hole stretch (score to par); this week marks his third made cut in seven starts at the Wells Fargo Championship (T47/2009, T18/2019)
- Defending champion **Max Homa** (T9) sits eight shots off the lead; no player has ever successfully defended the event
