**Weather:** *Mostly cloudy. High of 81. Wind ESE 5-10 mph.*

**Things to Know**

- Sam Burns wins the World Golf Championships-Dell Technologies Match Play, defeating Cameron Young in the Championship Match, 6 and 5
- Burns earns his fifth PGA TOUR victory in his 121<sup>st</sup> start at the age of 26 years, 8 months, 3 days
- Burns becomes the first player to win the Dell Technologies Match Play in his debut appearance since Geoff Ogilvy in 2006
- In search of his first PGA TOUR win, Cameron Young now has six runner-up finishes in 37 starts
- This week marks the first time since 2017 that both finalists entered the Championship Match with a perfect 6-0-0 record
- Rory McIlroy finishes third with a 2-and-1 victory over Scottie Scheffler in the Consolation Match

**Notes**

- Defeats Cameron Young, 6 and 5, for his fifth PGA TOUR victory in his 121<sup>st</sup> start
- The 6-and-5 victory is the largest at the event since 2018 when Bubba Watson defeated Kevin Kisner, 7 and 6
- PGA TOUR wins (5): 2021 Valspar Championship, 2021 Sanderson Farms Championship, 2022 Valspar Championship, 2022 Charles Schwab Challenge, 2023 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play
- Has now won in three consecutive seasons on TOUR
- After going winless in his first 75 TOUR starts, has five victories in his last 46 starts
- Becomes the first player to win in his Dell Technologies Match Play debut since Geoff Ogilvy in 2006; the only other player to perform the feat is Jeff Maggert at the inaugural event in 1999
- Moves to No. 8 in the FedExCup and No. 10 in the Official World Golf Ranking

#### **Additional Player Notes**

- Seeking his first PGA TOUR win and following a 6-and-5 loss to Sam Burns in the Championship Match, **Cameron Young** now has six runner-up finishes in 37 starts; posts a 6-1-0 record for the week, highlighted by a semifinal win in 19 holes over Rory McIlroy
- **Rory McIlroy** finishes third after defeating Scottie Scheffler, 2 and 1, in the Consolation Match; 2015 champion has four top-4 finishes in 13 starts at the event (2012/2<sup>nd</sup>, 2015/won, 2016/4<sup>th</sup>, 2023/3<sup>rd</sup>); with his victory over Scheffler, moves into solo-third place in match victories at the event: Tiger Woods (36), Matt Kuchar (36), McIlroy (34), Ian Poulter (33)
- **Scottie Scheffler** finishes fourth after falling to Rory McIlroy, 2 and 1, in the Consolation Match; has three top-4 finishes in as many starts at the event (2021/2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022/won, 2023/4<sup>th</sup>); lost in the Semifinals to Sam Burns in 21 holes in his bid to become the first player to advance to the Championship Match in three straight appearances
