Things to Know

- WGC-Dell Technologies Match play defending champion and No. 1 seed Scottie Scheffler wins his ninth straight match and improves to 14-2-2 at Austin Country Club
- Scheffler seeks to become the second player in tournament history to successfully defend (Tiger Woods/2004)
- Five players from the top 16 seeds advance to the Quarterfinals (Scheffler, McIlroy, Schauffele, Burns, Young)
- Three of the five past champions at Austin Country Club in this week’s field advanced to the Quarterfinals (Scheffler, McIlroy, Day)
- Six players advance Quarterfinals with a perfect 4-0-0 record
- Highest-seeded player to advance: Scottie Scheffler (1)
- Lowest-seeded player to advance: Mackenzie Hughes (50)

- Since his 7-0-0 performance in 2016, Day entered the week a combined 2-10-0 at Austin Country Club (note: withdrew in 2017 and conceded all three matches)

- With a 1-up win over J.T. Poston, defending champion and No. 1 seed Scottie Scheffler wins his ninth straight match and improves to 14-2-2 at Austin Country Club
- Is looking to advance to the Championship Match for the third time in as many starts
- Scheffler is seeking to become the first player since Tiger Woods (2007) to successfully defend multiple titles in a season (WM Phoenix Open); Woods performed the feat four times in 2007
- Tiger Woods is the only player in tournament history to successfully defend a title (2004)
