Things to Know

- Will Gordon holds a one-stroke lead after tying his career-low round on PGA TOUR with a 9-under 62
- Two-time defending champion Viktor Hovland (T7) opens with 6-under 65; last player to win a single PGA TOUR event three years in a row is Steve Stricker at the John Deere Classic (2009, 2010, 2011)
- Scottie Scheffler (T7) looks to reclaim World No. 1 with a win or solo-second this week
- World Wide Technology Championship at Mayakoba became the first PGA TOUR co-sanctioned event to ever be contested outside of the United States and Canada in February of 2007

- Making third start at the World Wide Technology Championship at Mayakoba (T55/2019, MC/2020)
- Seeks his first career PGA TOUR title in his 48th TOUR start; best career PGA TOUR finish: T3/2020 Travelers Championship
- Did not make a start on TOUR in the 2021-22 season and returned to the TOUR this season through 2022 Korn Ferry Tour Finals, highlighted with a victory at the 2022 Albertsons Boise Open presented by Chevron

Additional Notes

Making his fifth consecutive start at the World Wide Technology Championship at Mayakoba, Russell Henley (2nd/-8) records his career-low score in 13 rounds at the El Camaleón Golf Course (previous: 65/R1/2021/T56)

- World No. 2 and reigning PGA TOUR Player of the Year **Scottie Scheffler** (T7) opens with a 6-under 65 and has one top-10 in two starts at the event (4th/2021); would return to No. 1 in the Official World Golf Ranking with a win or solo-second this week
- Playing in the same group with Scottie Scheffler, two-time defending champion **Viktor Hovland** (T7) cards a 6-under 65, two strokes better than his opening score in his two wins at the event (67/2020, 2021); last player to record three straight wins at the same PGA TOUR event: Steve Stricker, John Deere Classic (2009, 2010, 2011)
- Winner of last week's Butterfield Bermuda Championship, Seamus Power (T28) opens with a 4-under 67 in his fifth tournament appearance (best: T11/2021); the last player to win back-to-back weeks on the TOUR schedule is Tony Finau (3M Open, Rocket Mortgage Classic in 2022)
- Four players from Mexico competing on sponsor exemptions in the field: **Sebastián Vázquez** (T65/-2), **Isidro Benitez** (T76/-1), **Armando Favela** (T76/-1), **José de Jesús Rodríguez** (T90/E)
