Russell Henley (1st/-12)

- Fifth outright lead in the last 10 rounds at the Wyndham Championship (first three rounds in 2021, first two rounds in 2023)
- Sixth player to hold the outright lead after each of the first two rounds of a TOUR event this season; Lee Hodges at last week's 3M Open is the only one of the previous five to go on to win

- Making his seventh start at the event, with three consecutive top-10 finishes (T9/2020, T7/2021, T5/2022)
- Won the World Wide Technology Championship earlier this season (seven multiple winners so far this season)
- Seven 36-hole leaders/co-leaders have won the Wyndham Championship since it moved back to Sedgefield Country Club in 2008 (most recent: Tom Kim, 2022)
- 13 36-hole leaders/co-leaders have gone on to win stroke-play events this season (most recent: Lee Hodges, 3M Open)

FedExCup Playoffs notes

- The Wyndham Championship is the final event of the FedExCup Regular Season, with the top 70 in the FedExCup standings qualifying for next week's FedEx St. Jude Championship (the first Playoffs event)
- **Billy Horschel** (2nd/-11) needs a two-way T2 to have a chance to move into the top 70 of the FedExCup standings and qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs; Horschel, who has qualified for the Playoffs in each of the last 10 seasons, is currently projected to move to No. 65 in the standings, bumping rookie **Austin Eckroat** out of the top 70 (only projected players moving in/out)
- Adam Scott (No. 81/projected No. 82) is one of two players who have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs in each season since the inception of the FedExCup in 2007; the other: Matt Kuchar (T31/-4; projected No. 58 in the FedExCup)
- All players who entered the week No. 71-74 in the FedExCup standings missed the cut and have been eliminated from FedExCup Playoffs contention (Ben Taylor, Garrick Higgo, K.H. Lee, David Lingmerth)
- Other notables making the cut that entered the week outside the top 70 include Shane Lowry (entered No. 76, projected No. 77), Justin Thomas (No. 79, No. 75) and Matt Wallace (No. 80, No. 76)

Miscellaneous notes

- Billy Horschel (2nd/-11) cards a career-low 62 in his 1,058th round on the PGA TOUR
- Lucas Glover (T3/-10) is making his 19th start at the Wyndham Championship, the most of any player since Glover joined the TOUR in 2004; Glover needs a two-way T2 or better to have a chance to qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs
