## Lucas Glover (T1/-18)

- With rounds of 66-64-62—192 (-18), records his best opening 54-hole score on TOUR (previous: 196 2010 Wyndham Championship/finished 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Shriners Children's Open/finished T9)
- Third-round 8-under 62 is his 17<sup>th</sup> consecutive par-or-better round on TOUR (currently 78-under in his last five starts)
- Is making his 19<sup>th</sup> start at the Wyndham Championship, the most of any player since he joined the TOUR in 2004; best finish came in 2006 (T6)
- Needs a two-way T2 or better to have a chance to qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs; currently projected No. 50 (sat No. 182 following the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday)
- Most recent of his four PGA TOUR victories came at the 2021 John Deere Classic
- Holds the 54-hole lead/co-lead for the fourth time on the PGA TOUR; is 0-for-3 in converting the third-round lead/co-lead to victory, most recently finishing third at the 2016 Shriners Children's Open
- 43-year-old is the oldest 54-hole leader/co-leader at the Wyndham Championship since Tom Lehman (45) in 2004

## Billy Horschel (T1/-18)

- Following a 7-under 63 to move to 18-under 192, posts his lowest opening 54-hole score on TOUR (previous: 195/2020 Wyndham Championship/finished 2<sup>nd</sup>)
- With rounds of 62-63, equals the lowest 36-hole score (any rounds) on TOUR this season (fourth occasion)
- 2014 FedExCup Champion has qualified for the Playoffs in each of the last 10 seasons; needs a two-way T2 to have a chance to move into the top 70 of the FedExCup standings and qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs (currently projected No. 53)
- Making his 11<sup>th</sup> start at the event, with three top-10 finishes in his last six starts (T5/2016, T6/2019, 2<sup>nd</sup>/2020)
- Most recent of his seven PGA TOUR victories came at the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday in 2022
- Holds the 54-hole lead/co-lead for the sixth time on the PGA TOUR; is 3-for-5 in converting the third-round lead/co-lead to victory (Won/2014 BMW Championship, 2014 TOUR Championship, 2022 Memorial Tournament presented by Workday)

## 54-hole leader notes

- Eight 54-hole leaders/co-leaders have won the Wyndham Championship since it moved back to Sedgefield Country Club in 2008 (most recent: Brandt Snedeker/2018)
- 23 54-hole leaders/co-leaders have gone on to win stroke-play events this season (most recent: Lee Hodges, 3M Open)
- Glover and Horschel's 54-hole total (192) falls one shy of the tournament record (191/Carl Pettersson/2008)

## FedExCup Playoffs notes

- The Wyndham Championship is the final event of the FedExCup Regular Season, with the top 70 in the FedExCup standings qualifying for next week's FedEx St. Jude Championship (the first Playoffs event)
- Players projected to move into the top 70 in the standings: Lucas Glover (No. 112/projected No. 50), Billy Horschel (No. 116/projected No. 53)
- Players projected to fall out of the top 70 in the standings: **Ben Griffin** (No. 68/projected No. 71), **Austin Eckroat** (No. 70/projected No. 74)

• Matt Kuchar (T51/-3; projected No. 62 in the FedExCup) is one of two players who have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs in each season since the inception of the FedExCup in 2007; the other: Adam Scott (T34/-5; projected No. 84)

# **Miscellaneous notes**

- First- and second-round outright leader **Russell Henley** (3<sup>rd</sup>/-17) posts a 5-under 65 and falls one stroke behind the leaders; making his seventh start at the Wyndham Championship, with three consecutive top-10 finishes (T9/2020, T7/2021, T5/2022); won the World Wide Technology Championship earlier this season (seven multiple winners so far this season)
- **Byeong Hun An** (4<sup>th</sup>/-15) cards a 5-under 65, his 11<sup>th</sup> straight round in the 60s at the Wyndham Championship; carried a one-stroke lead into the final round in 2019 en route to his best finish (3<sup>rd</sup>) in four prior starts at Sedgefield Country Club
- With a 3-under 67, **Sungjae Im** (T16/-8) posts his 16th consecutive round in the 60s at the Wyndham Championship (longest active streak) and his 19<sup>th</sup> par-or-better score in as many rounds at the event; currently projected No. 32, is seeking his fifth consecutive trip to the season-ending TOUR Championship
