Lucas Glover (Winner/-20)

- Earns his fifth career PGA TOUR title in his 512th start at the age of 43 years, 8 months, 25 days
- PGA TOUR wins (5):** 2005 FUNAI Classic at the Walt Disney World Resort, 2009 U.S. Open, 2011 Wells Fargo Championship, 2021 John Deere Classic, 2023 Wyndham Championship
- Moves up 63 spots from No. 112 to No. 49 in the FedExCup standings, qualifying for the FedExCup Playoffs for the fifth consecutive season and 13th total
- Third player in the FedExCup era (est. 2007) to enter the Wyndham Championship outside the bubble for the FedExCup Playoffs and win to get in, joining Davis Love III (2015) and Jim Herman (2020), who were outside the top 125
- Sat No. 182 in the FedExCup standings following the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday
- Oldest PGA TOUR winner since Phil Mickelson at the 2021 PGA Championship (50 years, 11 months, 7 days)
- One of two players aged 40 or older with multiple wins in the last three seasons (other: Stewart Cink)
- Improves to 1-for-4 converting the third-round lead/co-lead to victory on the PGA TOUR (held a share of 54-hole lead)
- Final-round 2-under 68 is his 18th consecutive par-or-better round on TOUR (80-under total in his last five starts)
- 72-hole total of 260 is the lowest of his PGA TOUR career (previous: 262, 2022 Sony Open in Hawaii)
- Moves from No. 117 to No. 53 in the Official World Golf Ranking

FedExCup Playoffs notes

- Lucas Glover** (moving from No. 112 to No. 49) is the only player that entered the week outside the top 70 and moved in to qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs, bumping out rookie **Austin Eckroat**, who entered the week No. 70 and missed the cut (fell to No. 74)
- With **Adam Scott** (T7) finishing No. 72 in the FedExCup standings, **Matt Kuchar** is now the only player that has qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs in each season since the inception of the FedExCup in 2007
- Justin Thomas** (T12) finishes the FedExCup Regular Season No. 71 in the FedExCup standings, snapping a streak of eight consecutive seasons qualifying for the FedExCup Playoffs and seven straight appearances in the TOUR Championship

Miscellaneous notes

- First- and second-round outright leader **Russell Henley** finishes T2, earning his fourth consecutive top-10 at the Wyndham Championship
- Charley Hoffman** (T12/-11) records an albatross on No. 15, holing out from 198 yards; first albatross of Hoffman's PGA TOUR career and fourth albatross on TOUR this season
- With a 2-under 68, **Sungjae Im** (T16/-8) posts his 17th consecutive round in the 60s at the Wyndham Championship (longest active streak) and his 20th par-or-better score in as many rounds at the event
