- Rickie Fowler and Andrew Putnam share 36-hole lead/co lead at 10-under at the 2022 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP
- In his ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP debut, John Huh breaks course record by two strokes with 9-under 61
- 22-year-old Keita Nakajima (5) has the best score among 16 Japanese players in the field in his PGA TOUR debut
- Defending champion Hideki Matsuyama (T48) shoots even in second round of ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP
- The ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP was launched as Japan's first official PGA TOUR tournament in 2019 and is in the fourth edition of the event and third time being played in Japan

- Playing on a sponsor exemption, five-time PGA TOUR winner seeks to end three year winless drought in his third start of the 2022-23 PGA TOUR Season
- Last time holding 36-hole lead/co-lead was the 2020 American Express; went on to finish T10
- Leads the field in most birdies made through 36 holes (14)
- Making his 299th TOUR start and third at the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP (T57/2020, T44/2021)
- Best finish in two previous starts this season: T6/Fortinet Championship

Keegan Bradley (3rd/-9)

- In his 10th round at the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, Keegan Bradley posts bogey-free 65
- Seeks to improve upon best finish in third tournament appearance (T7/2021)
- In search of fifth PGA TOUR title since winning the 2018 BMW Championship
- This week marks his second start of the 2022-2023 PGA TOUR Season (T5/Sanderson Farms Championship)

Miscellaneous notes

- In his ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP debut, John Huh (4) breaks course record with 9-under 61 (previous: Rory McIlroy, third round, 2019; Keegan Bradley, second round, 2019); ties career low 18-hole score 61 (2022/Wyndham Championship)
- Playing on a sponsor exemption, former world No. 1 amateur Keita Nakajima (5) has the best score among 16
 Japanese players in the field in his PGA TOUR debut
- 18-hole leader **Brendan Steele** post 3-over 73, falls 23 positions to T24
- 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games gold medalist **Xander Schauffele** (T13) posts 1-under 69; making fourth tournament start (T10/2019, T17/2020, T28/2021)
- Ehime, Japan native and defending champion **Hideki Matsuyama** shoots even par and falls to T49 going into the third round; has won one tournament back-to-back on the PGA TOUR (WM Phoenix Open/2016-17)
