Things to Know

- Keegan Bradley comes from behind to win his fifth career PGA TOUR victory at the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP
- Bradley earns first win since the 2018 BMW Championship, a span of 1,498 days
- With the victory, Bradley overtakes Mackenzie Hughes for the lead in the FedExCup
- Second- and third-round leader Rickie Fowler finishes runner-up for the 15th time in 299 PGA TOUR starts
- 36-hole co-leader Andrew Putnam (T2) records best finish since runner-up at the 2021 Barracuda Championship
- At T12, Keita Nakajima and Ryo Hisatsune earn the best finish amongst 16 Japanese players in the field
- Defending champion Hideki Matsuyama finishes T40

Keegan Bradley (Winner/-15)

- Fifth career PGA TOUR victory and first since the 2018 BMW Championship
 - 100th PGA TOUR start since
 - 4 years, 1 month, 7 days (1,498 days since)
- Entered the final round trailing Rickie Fowler by one stroke; all five wins have been in come-from-behind fashion
- At 36 years, 4 months, 9 days, becomes the oldest winner on TOUR since Chez Reavie at the 2022 Barracuda Championship (40 years, 8 months, 5 days)
- Collects 500 points and moves to No. 1 in the FedExCup standings
- Win comes in his third start at the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP (T13/2019, T7/2021, Won/2022)
- Second top-five in as many starts this season (T5/Sanderson Farms Championship)
- PGA TOUR victories (5): 2011 AT&T Byron Nelson, 2011 PGA Championship, 2012 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational, 2018 BMW Championship, 2022 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP

Rickie Fowler (T2/-14)

- Entered the final round with one-stroke lead, closed with even-par 70
- With a span of 1,351 days since his last victory (2019 WM Phoenix Open), was seeking sixth career PGA TOUR title
- Falls to 2-for-9 when holding the third-round lead/co-lead and 1-for-11 with the second-round lead/co-lead

- Was seeking to become the first sponsor exemption to win on TOUR since Martin Laird at the 2020 Shriners Children's Open
- Picks up his best finish on TOUR since T3 at the 2021 THE CJ CUP @ SUMMIT
- Second top-10 in three starts this season (T6/Fortinet Championship)

Miscellaneous notes

- Seeking his second PGA TOUR win (2018 Barracuda Championship), **Andrew Putnam** (T2/-14) records his best finish on TOUR since finishing runner-up at the 2021 Barracuda Championship
- In his first PGA TOUR start as a professional, former world amateur No. 1 **Keita Nakajima** (T12/-9) earned his career-best finish in his sixth TOUR start (previous: T28/2021 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP)
- In his season debut, 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games gold medalist **Xander Schauffele** (T9/-10) records his second top-10 at the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP (T10/2019)
- Defending champion **Hideki Matsuyama** finishes T40 in attempt to become the first multiple winner of the event
