Collin Morikawa (Winner/-14)

- Collects his sixth PGA TOUR title in his 99th start at the age of 26 years, 8 months, 16 days
- PGA TOUR wins (6): 2019 Barracuda Championship, 2020 Workday Charity Open, 2020 PGA Championship, 2021 WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession, 2021 The Open Championship, 2023 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP
- Earns first TOUR title since the 2021 Open Championship and first worldwide victory since the 2021 DP World Tour Championship
- Of his five TOUR titles in standard stroke-play events, has won four when trailing through 54 holes (led at the 2021 WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession); began the final round at the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP two strokes back of leader Justin Suh
- Bogey-free 63 is lowest final-round score by a winner in tournament history (previous: 65, Hideki Matsuyama/2021; Patrick Cantlay/2020); marks his lowest final-round score of the season
- Six strokes marks the largest margin of victory in tournament history (previous: 5 strokes/Hideki Matsuyama/2021)
- Played his final 24 holes at ACCORDIA GOLF Narashino CC in 12-under
- Led the field in Total Birdies with 24 despite finishing T67 in Driving Accuracy Percentage (36.54%/19 of 52)
- Wins in his first start on TOUR since the TOUR Championship, where he finished T6

FedExCup Fall Notes

- The top 125 in the FedExCup Fall standings thru The RSM Classic will be exempt into Full-Field events and THE PLAYERS Championship next season
- Nos. 51-60 in the standings at the conclusion of The RSM Classic will qualify for two Signature Events in 2024 via The Next 10 (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, The Genesis Invitational)
- Players currently projected to move into The Next 10: J.J. Spaun (No. 63 to No. 56)

Miscellaneous notes

- PGA TOUR Rookie Eric Cole (T2/-8) birdies the final two holes to collect his second career runner-up finish on TOUR (2023 The Classic in The Palm Beaches) and sixth top-10 in 36 starts this season, including three of his last four (4th/Fortinet Championship, T3/Shriners Children's Open, T2/ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP); The Arnold Palmer Award (PGA TOUR Rookie of the Year) will be voted on after the FedExCup Fall
- Beau Hossler (T2/-8) earns back-to-back top-10 finishes on TOUR (T7/Shriners Children's Open) and his third career runner-up finish (2nd/2018 Texas Children's Houston Open, T2/2018 Travelers Championship); final-round 70 marks his 19th consecutive round of par or better on TOUR dating back to round two of the FedEx St. Jude Championship
- Having qualified for his 157th PGA TOUR start as one of the top eight players on the Japan Golf Tour Money List, **Ryo Ishikawa** (T4/-7) posts his 12th career top-10 finish and first since the 2016 CIMB Classic (T10)

- Entering the week having missed the cut in nine of his last 11 starts on TOUR, **Robby Shelton** (T4/-7) closes with 65 and earns his first top-10 on TOUR since the 2023 American Express (T6)
- Among the 14 Japanese players in the field, **Ryo Ishikawa** (T4/-7), **Kensei Hirata** (T6/-6) and **Ryo Hisatsune** (T6/-6) finish inside the top 10 and earn exemptions into the World Wide Technology Championship (Nov. 2-5); 2021 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP winner **Hideki Matsuyama** posts 2-over 72 to finish T51
