Extended forecast – A quick moving front will push through southern Wisconsin tonight with a period of showers likely developing, especially between 2-7am Sunday. While a few rumbles of thunder can't be ruled out, instability is nearly non-existent. A few lingering showers are possible until 9am Sunday, otherwise skies will gradually clear with much cooler conditions in place. Northeast winds will also be a factor with gusts of 20-25 mph expected much of the day.
