Things to Know

- 36-hole leader **Stephen Ames** played his final five holes in 6-under to run away with a seven-stroke win over defending champion **Miguel Angel Jimenez**.

Stephen Ames, 67-67-63 – 197 (-19)

- The 59-year-old earned his sixth win on PGA TOUR Champions (188 starts)
- Earned his fourth win of the 2023 season (14 starts)
 - Also won the Trophy Hassan II (Feb. 9-11), Mitsubishi Electric Classic (May 5-7) and Principal Charity Classic (June 2-4)
 - Becomes the second four-time winner this season on the Champions Tour, along with Steve Stricker (5)
- This is the largest margin of victory (7) this season on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Note: This is the 18th event of 2023
 - It is also the largest margin of victory in Boeing Classic history
- Today's round matched his second-lowest 18-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions (586 rounds)
 - It is his lowest round since shooting 63 in the first round of the 2020 Morocco Champions
- Matched his second-lowest 54-hole score (197) on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Also shot 197 at the 2023 Mitsubishi Electric Classic
 - His low 54-hole score: 196 (2018 Charles Schwab Cup Championship)
- Matched the lowest 54-hole score in Boeing Classic history (197)
 - Previous instance: Jerry Kelly (2017)
- Improved to 5-for-9 when leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions, converting each of his last four attempts
- Is 4-for-4 when playing in the last group of the final round this season on PGA TOUR Champions
- Moves up to No. 3 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings

Other Notes

- Defending champion **Miguel Angel Jimenez** finished second at 12-under to match his best finish of the 2023 season (Previous instance: 2nd/Mitsubishi Electric Classic). It is his 11th top-10 finish of the season (16 starts).
- Reigning Charles Schwab Cup winner **Steven Alker** finished T3 at 10-under. It is his 21st top-3 finish on PGA TOUR Champions (45 starts).

- **K.J. Choi** closed with 65 to finish T3 at 10-under. It is his second top-3 in his last three starts (Also: T3/Kaulig Companies Championship).
- Two-time Boeing Classic champion (2010, 2016) **Bernhard Langer** finished T5 at 8-under, along with **Stuart Appleby** and **Keith Horne**.
- World Golf Hall of Fame member and Boeing ambassador **Ernie Els** finished T18 at 4-under.
- World Golf Hall of Fame member and Seattle native **Fred Couples** finished T26 at 3-under.
- Making his debut on PGA TOUR Champions, **Boo Weekley** finished T66 at 10-over.
