Things to Know

- 36-hole leader Brett Quigley held off final-round charges from Steven Alker and Glen Day on his way to a onestroke win at the Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS presented by Circle K.
- The final two groupings shot a combined 11-over par on Sunday, with the champion Quigley (71) being the only player among those groups to break par in the final round.

Brett Quigley, 67-67-71 – 205 (-11)

- The 54-year-old earned his second win on PGA TOUR Champions (82 starts)
 Last win: 2020 Morocco Champions
- Earned his first win of the 2023 season (20 starts)
 - Previous best finish: T3 (Trophy Hassan II, Ascension Charity Classic)
 - This is his ninth top-10 finish of the season
- Moves up to No. 11 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings
- Improved to 1-for-5 when leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions
- Becomes the 14th different player to win this season on PGA TOUR Champions (24 events)
 - This is the second-highest winning score in a 54-hole event on PGA TOUR Champions this season (205)
 - Highest: 210 (Stephen Ames/Trophy Hassan II)

Other Notes

•

- Reigning Charles Schwab Cup winner Steven Alker closed with 68 to finish runner-up at 10-under and moves up to No. 3 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings.
 - This is Alker's 15th top-2 finish on PGA TOUR Champions (49 starts).
- **Glen Day** carded 68 for the second consecutive day to finish third at 9-under. This is his first top-10 finish of the 2023 season (20 starts) and earns him a spot into next week's SAS Championship.
 - o It is his best finish since the 2020 Charles Schwab Series at Bass Pro Shops Big Cedar Lodge (T2).
- Jerry Kelly and World Golf Hall of Fame member Ernie Els each finished T4 at 8-under. It marks Els' fifth top-5 finish of the 2023 season.

- Ken Tanigawa, who matched the low round of the day (67), finished T6 along with Joe Durant, Robert Karlsson and Billy Andrade.
 - **John Huston** (T24) matched Tanigawa's round of 67 on Sunday.
- Defending champion and Charles Schwab Cup leader **Steve Stricker** (T15) played Nos. 4-10 in 5-over en route to 73 in the final round. His T15 finish snapped a streak of 19 consecutive top-10 finishes on PGA TOUR Champions (dating back to last season), which ranks as the fourth-longest streak in Tour history.
- Jacksonville native **David Duval** finished T47 at 1-over.
- Tournament host **Jim Furyk** finished T53 at 4-over.
