Extended forecast – Dry and quiet conditions are favored tonight and much of the day Saturday. There will be an increasing threat for showers/T-storms Saturday night and especially on Sunday as an upper-level disturbance interacts with a stalled front boundary. This forecast remains tricky, since the area of organized precipitation will only be 25-50 miles wide. While instability levels will be marginal, some embedded lightning strikes are also possible. Otherwise, it will be cool and cloudy on Sunday with brisk northeast winds gusting up to 25 mph. Unsettled conditions should persist into Monday as well.
