**Today** – Cloud cover will continue to increase this morning with a cold front sinking into northern Texas. This front should push into the DFW Metro after 3-4pm. While moisture and instability is limited, a low threat (10-15%) for a shower/T-storm will exist this afternoon. Winds will generally remain under 15 mph ahead of the front but should become northeasterly and increase rapidly once the front passes.

**Tomorrow** – A cool, wet, and dreary day is expected across north Texas Sunday. An area of organized rain showers will develop early Sunday morning and spread across the DFW Metro. The heaviest rainfall is expected before 6am-12pm with some embedded T-storms also possible during this period. The threat for showers should begin to diminish during the afternoon hours. Temperatures will struggle to climb out of the 50s with a brisk northeast wind gusting 20-25 mph. Forecast rainfall: 0.25-0.50".
