Tomorrow – Monday features a complicated forecast as it is dependent on the evaluation of upstream T-storm complexes tonight. At this point, it appears a weakening complex will approach northern Georgia late tonight into tomorrow morning. Additional showers/T-storms may develop Monday afternoon but the early morning activity could stabilize the atmosphere. Because of this, the forecast will favor the highest shower/T-storm chances before noon. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.25". **Sunrise: 6:40am / Sunset: 8:25pm**
