Tournament Preview

The PNC Championship returns to the Ritz-Carlton Golf Club in Orlando, Florida this week, with competition days set for Saturday and Sunday. The PNC Championship is a two-day, 36-hole tournament that uses a two-person team Scramble format.

The event, which began in 1995, was originally named the Father/Son Challenge and intended for professional golfers to play competitive golf alongside their sons. In recent years, the field has expanded to include players' daughters, fathers and grandchildren, and in 2020, the name was changed to PNC Championship to reflect the high level of competition and the field composition while still celebrating the family relationships.

A member of each team must have won at least one major (PGA TOUR, LPGA or PGA TOUR Champions) or THE PLAYERS Championship title, while the partner must not hold any playing status on a professional Tour.
