## Things to Know

- Team Langer (Bernhard/Jason) overcame a three-stroke deficit to win the PNC Championship for a record-tying fifth time. They were the lone team to break 60 in the final round, carding 59 en route to a two-stroke triumph.
- The PNC Championship is a two-day, 36-hole tournament that uses a two-person team Scramble format.
- A member of each of the 20 teams holds at least one major title (PGA TOUR, LPGA or PGA TOUR Champions) or THE PLAYERS Championship title, while the partner does not hold any playing status on a professional Tour.


## Team Langer (Bernhard/Jason), 60-59 - 119 (-25)

- Birdied 13 of 18 holes, including Nos. 1-7, to close with 13 -under 59
- Matched Team Langer's low 18-hole score at the PNC Championship (fourth time)
- Captured their record-tying fifth title at the PNC Championship (2005, 2006, 2014, 2019, 2023)
- Matched Raymond Floyd (1995, 1996, 1997, 2000, 2001) for the most wins in the 26 -year history of the PNC Championship
- Note: Langer won with son Jason in 2014 and 2019; won with son Stefan in 2005 and 2006
- Making their 18th appearance at the PNC Championship, this is Team Langer's low 36-hole score (119)
- Previous low 36-hole score: 120 (three times; last: 2019)


## Other Notes

- 2016 champion Team Duval (David/Brady) closed with eagle on the par-5 18th to shoot 61 and finish runner-up at 23 -under. Making their 11th appearance at the PNC Championship, this is Team Duval's low 36 -hole score (121).
- Defending champion Team Singh (Vijay/Qass) finished at 22-under (3rd) after posting 62 in the final round.
- Team Goosen (Retief/Leo) finished at 21-under (4th) for a fourth top-5 finish in five starts at the PNC Championship.
- First-round leader Team Kuchar (Matt/Cameron) followed a 15 -under 57 with 68 in the final round to finish T 5 .
- Team Woods (Tiger/Charlie) birdied five of their last six holes to card 61 and finish T5. In four appearances at the PNC Championship, Team Woods has finished 7th-2nd-T8-T5.
- Team Lehman (Tom/Sean), 2021 champion Team Daly (John/John II) and 2013 champion Team Cink (Stewart/Reagan) also finished T5.
