Today – Light rain showers will move into Orlando by mid to late morning and will likely become a steady light to moderate rain as we head towards Noon. Moderate rain will continue through the rest of the afternoon with a few thunderstorms becoming possible towards evening. Rain and thunderstorms will be likely tonight with heavy rainfall at times. Storms could be severe tonight with strong winds and isolated tornadoes. The wind will increase to 15-20 and become 20-25 gusting to 35 mph late in the day.
