Additionally, the highest threat may hold off until after the round, with 4-7pm the favored timeframe. Temperatures should climb into the upper 80s with a southeast wind up to 15 mph. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.25” with localized higher amounts possible. **Sunrise: 5:42am / Sunset: 8:42pm**

**Extended forecast** – High pressure centered over the Great Lakes will expand westward this weekend, with a slightly drier and more stable airmass spreading across Iowa. While shower/T-storm chances between 10-15% will be left in the forecast, development Saturday/Sunday afternoon will be extremely limited. Temperatures will remain warm, with afternoon highs near 90 degrees both days. Easterly winds will be in place with a few gusts around 15 mph.
