Things to Know

• Charles Schwab Cup leader **Steve Stricker** captured his sixth win of the 2023 season and defended his title at the Sanford International presented by First PREMIER Bank & Mastercard.

Steve Stricker, 62-66-66 - 194 (-16)

- The 56-year-old earned his 17th win overall on PGA TOUR Champions (62 starts)
 - o Remains in 17th place on the PGA TOUR Champions all-time wins list
 - o Improves his winning percentage on PGA TOUR Champions to 27.4%
- Earned his sixth win of the season, most among all players in 2023 (15 starts)
 - o Moves into T9 on the PGA TOUR Champions single-season wins list
 - Becomes the third player since 2000 to win six or more times in a single season on PGA TOUR Champions, joining Bernhard Langer (seven wins in 2017) and Larry Nelson (six wins in 2000)
- Extended his lead in the Charles Schwab Cup standings to \$2,065,705 over No. 2 Bernhard Langer
 - With his finish this week, Stricker set the PGA TOUR Champions record for money earned in a season (\$3,956,127)
- Becomes the first three-time winner in the six-year history of the Sanford International (2018, 2022, 2023)
 - o In five starts at the Sanford International, he has never finished outside of the top 6 (1st-T3-6th-1st-1st)
- Set the Sanford International 54-hole scoring record (194)
 - o Previous: 196 (three times)
- This is the fifth successful title defense this season on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Previous instances in 2023: Bernhard Langer (Chubb Classic), Steven Alker (Insperity Invitational), Steve
 Stricker (Regions Tradition) and Padraig Harrington (DICK'S Sporting Goods Open)
- Notched his 19th consecutive top-10 on PGA TOUR Champions, dating back to last season, which is the fourthlongest streak in Champions Tour history
- This is his 11th top-2 finish of the season (15 starts)

Other Notes

• Seeking his first win since 2021, **K.J. Choi** (15-under) finished runner-up at the Sanford International for the second time in three years (2021, 2023). This is Choi's third top-3 finish of the season (19 starts).

- **Joe Durant** birdied each of the last three holes en route to a third-place finish at 13-under. This is Durant's second top-3 finish of the season (20 starts).
- 66-year-old **Bernhard Langer** (4th) bettered his age with 64 on Sunday to finish at 12-under. This is Langer's 10th time shooting his age or better on PGA TOUR Champions (fourth time in 2023).
- Paul Stankowski and Alex Cejka each finished T5 at 11-under.
- John Daly, David Toms and Paul Broadhurst each finished T7 at 10-under.
- Lee Janzen (T12) carded the round of the day with 7-under 63.
- Jerry Kelly (T12) made a hole-in-one on No. 17 with a 6-iron from 186 yards.
- Making his debut on PGA TOUR Champions, South Dakota's **Ryan Jansa** finished T55 at even-par.
- 72-year-old open qualifier **Dick Mast** (T67) bettered his age for the third consecutive round with 1-over 71.
