#### Things to Know

- 18-hole leader **Rod Pampling** birdied Nos. 17 and 18 in the second round to take a one-stroke lead over a trio of players entering the final round.
- The second round resumed on Sunday at 7:45 a.m. after play was suspended due to darkness on Saturday at 6:43 p.m.
- Players are in the same groupings for the final round (tee times from 10:30 a.m. to 12:36 p.m. off Nos. 1 and 10).

## Rod Pampling, 66-68 – 134 (-10)

- This is his low 36-hole score of the 2023 season (134) •
  - Previous low: 135 (three times)
- This is his first time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions Previous best position: T2 (three times)
- The 54-year-old seeks his second win on PGA TOUR Champions (85th start)
  - Last win: 2021 Boeing Classic
- Seeks his first win of the 2023 season (24th start)
  - Has three top-10s this season
    - Best finish: T4 (Principal Charity Classic)
- Making his fifth appearance at the SAS Championship, his best finish is T12 (2019)

## **Other Notes**

- Reigning Charles Schwab Cup winner Steven Alker birdied each of his last three holes to card 68 and sits T2 at 9-under. 0
  - The 52-year-old seeks his seventh win on PGA TOUR Champions (50th start).
- **Paul Broadhurst** closed with three consecutive birdies to post 67 and sits T2 at 9-under.
  - The 58-year-old seeks his sixth win on PGA TOUR Champions (171st start).
- World Golf Hall of Fame member Vijay Singh sits T2 at 9-under after shooting 68 in the second round.
  - The 60-year-old seeks his sixth win on PGA TOUR Champions (132nd start).
- John Huston carded the low second-round score with 7-under 65. He sits T5 at 8-under along with Jerry Kelly, Robert Karlsson and World Golf Hall of Fame member Retief Goosen.
