Extended forecast – Tropical moisture will quickly spread across south Florida tonight into Saturday. This moisture combined with an approaching upper-level disturbance should allow for increased shower development offshore. Some of this activity will occasionally move inland during this period. Lightning will also be possible, although the higher threat likely remains offshore. The threat for showers should linger into Sunday, although the bulk of the day will remain dry. Northeasterly winds can be expected through the weekend with some gusts over 20 mph at times.
