Things to Know

- 36-hole leader **Stephen Ames** closed with a bogey-free 73 to post a five-stroke victory at the Hassan II Trophy in Rabat, Morocco on Saturday.

Stephen Ames, 67-70-73 – 210 (-9)

- Played the final 21 holes bogey-free – including 18 pars in the final round – to claim his fourth victory on PGA TOUR Champions. (176 starts)
 - Last win: 2021 Principal Charity Classic
- Ames is now 2 for 6 in converting his share of the lead after Rounds 1 and 2 into victories (2017 Mitsubishi Electric Classic).
- Ames went wire-to-wire in his victory, the first time he has done so on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Ames is the first player on PGA TOUR Champions to do go wire-to-wire since the 2022 Regions Tradition (Steve Stricker)
 - Ames also led after Rounds 1 and 2 at the 2020 Morocco Champions event in Marrakesh, finishing the event solo second.

Other Notes

- **Mark Hensby** finished the tournament at four-under, earning solo second place after recording a final round 75. The solo second is his best-ever finish on PGA TOUR Champions (11 starts).
 - Previous best: Solo third at 2022 U.S. Senior Open
- Four players finished the tournament T3 at 3-under 216.
 - 2023 PGA TOUR Champions Q-School medalist **Richard Green**, who began Round 3 at 1-over, tallied four birdies on the day en route to a three-under 70. This marks his highest career finish on PGA TOUR Champions (four starts)
 - Previous best: T41/2022 The Senior Open Championship presented by Rolex
 - **Paul Stankowski** birdied three of his last five holes to tally a two-under 71 in Round 3. The T3 stands as his best finish since the 2022 PURE Insurance Championship presented by First Tee (T2).
 - **Robert Karlsson** birdied his last hole to go one-over on the day (74) finishing the tournament at T3.
 - This is his best finish on PGA TOUR Champions since being defeated in a playoff at the

2022 Sanford International (T2).

- 2020 Morocco Champions winner **Brett Quigley** finished the final nine holes bogey-free to post his best finish since the 2022 The Ally Challenge (T2).
- There were five eagles in the final round, all on hole 17.
