Extended forecast – The mid-level feature continues to spin off the Pacific NW coast while further deepening. This increase in intensity will continue into tomorrow providing a slight uptick in the winds through the PM hours on Friday. A few gusts tomorrow could reach near 22-24mph. As the feature finally works towards Boise late Friday into Saturday, an increasing chance for scattered showers is forecast. Much of the precipitation is expected through Saturday as on/off showers and a low threat for a pop-up t-storm or two develops across the region. Conditions will begin to clear late Saturday into Sunday morning with NW'ly winds relaxing late in the weekend.
