Today – Partly cloudy skies and a few isolated showers are roaming south of the course early this morning. This trend is expected throughout the late AM/early PM with mostly cloudy conditions and a threat for isolated shower activity across portions of Bogota. Coverage of activity will be sparse, but some light precipitation is possible. PM highs nearing 70F (21C). A light east wind will develop by noon.

Extended forecast – Precipitation chances over the weekend will further decrease with dry air becoming more prominent. A threat for isolated showers each afternoon will continue, but the coverage of any activity will be limited. Afternoon highs will continue to reach the upper-60s alongside a variable wind turning E'ly each afternoon. The speed of winds will stay suppressed, only peaking near 8-10mph.
