Today – Partly cloudy skies are expected through the morning hours with temperatures rising into the upper-60s by noon. A threat for isolated thunderstorm development is forecast by noon-1PM with chances peaking around 2-4PM. Coverage of activity will be more reduced than prior days as drier air begins to infiltrate the region, but a threat for development still remains. Winds generally variable this AM before becoming E/SE nearing 8-10mph.

Extended forecast – With the subtle change ongoing today into tomorrow, chances for afternoon storms will continue to decrease as we move into the early weekend. Partly cloudy skies are forecast each morning with temperatures climbing towards 70F (21C) in the mid-afternoon. Even with chances for storms decreasing the next three days, a low chance for an isolated cell is still expected. Winds will start light and variable each morning before weakly developing out of the east.
