Extended forecast – Significant heat will begin to build across Oklahoma this weekend as air temperatures climb well into the 90s to near 100 degrees. Peak heat indices on Saturday will be near 100F and 105F on Sunday. A weak front will be positioned near Oklahoma City on Sunday so the potential for showers/T-storms will be monitored. However, given the limited signal for precipitation on model guidance only a 15% chance for showers/T-storms will be mentioned in the forecast.
