**Extended forecast** – The main cold front will arrive across the area overnight tonight into early Sat morning providing a threat for heavy thunderstorms. The threat timing for the corridor of heavier precipitation is forecast between 2AM-6AM Sat with some likelihood for lingering showers/storms on the backside of the front through Sat mid-day. Heavy rainfall and strong winds are the main threats and rainfall totals on the order of 0.40"-0.75" are expected from Fri PM through Sat AM. Heavier totals remain possible if storms are able to track across the same general region overnight into Saturday AM.
