Extended forecast – Some adjustments to the weekend forecast have become necessary as a weak front likely moves into the region. The main change was to add a low (25%) chance for showers/T-storms Friday night into Saturday morning. Between Saturday afternoon and Sunday evening, dry conditions are still favored. However, with the front lingering over the area, a very low (10%) chances for shower/T-storms remains warranted during this specific period. Temperatures will remain unseasonable warm through the weekend. Outside of Saturday, wind speeds will likely remain under 15 mph.
