Sunday – Scattered showers move into the area this morning with increasing thunderstorm chances during the late afternoon into this evening, although coverage of afternoon thunderstorms may more of the hit-or-miss variety. High temperatures reach the mid-upper 70s under increased cloud coverage and south to southeast winds will be less than 10 mph during the final round.

Rainfall: 0.10-0.25" on average with locally higher amounts to 0.50" possible.

Monday – Tricky forecast Monday with decaying storms moving into northern Illinois from the west during the morning hours. Isolated hit-or-miss showers and weak thunderstorms are possible through the first half of the day, with increasing chances for scattered thunderstorms during the late afternoon and evening as instability rebuilds during the day.

Rainfall: 0.10-0.20" on average with locally higher amounts possible.
